



Erez Vigodman
President & Chief Executive Officer

Erez Vigodman became Teva's President and Chief Executive Officer in February 2014 after joining Teva's Board of Directors in 2009.

From 2010 to 2014, he served as President and Chief Executive Officer of Adama Agricultural Solutions Ltd. (formerly Makhteshim Agan Industries Ltd.), the world's leading generic crop protection (agrochemical) company and the world's seventh largest company in the global agronomical industry.

From 2001 to 2009, he served as President and Chief Executive Officer of Strauss Group, Global food and beverage company.

Between 1998 to 2001 Erez served as CEO of Elite, the leading coffee and confectionary company in Israel. This appointment was sealed about a year after he had joined Elite as CFO and Deputy CEO.

Prior to that Erez served as a senior partner in PWC (today KPMG in Israel) between 1991-1996, which he joined at the end of 1987 upon graduating from Tel Aviv University.

Mr. Vigodman is a member of the Advisory Committee to the Israel National Economic Council (Prime Minister Office), and the International Advisory Board of the Israel Science Technology & Innovation Policy Institute.

Mr. Vigodman was a member of the advisory board to the governor of the bank of Israel (during the years Stanley Fischer was the governor of the Bank).
