Amir Lerman, MD is a professor of medicine and a consultant in the Department of Cardiovascular Diseases at the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine. Dr. Lerman serves as an associate chair and the director for research for the Department of Cardiovascular Diseases and the director of the Mayo Clinic Cardiovascular Research Center. In addition, Dr. Lerman leads the Mayo-Israeli start-up companies initiative and serves as a faculty member of the Merage Institute.

Dr. Lerman graduated from the Technion School of Medicine in Haifa, Israel, and completed his training in internal medicine, cardiovascular diseases and invasive cardiology at Mayo Clinic. Dr. Lerman is interested in coronary physiology and imaging in cardiovascular disease as well as regenerative medicine and digital health.

Dr. Lerman has published more than 500 manuscripts, book chapters and reviews. His research is supported by the National Institutes of Health, the American Hospital Association and several independent foundations.
