Dr. Shahar Arzy studied medicine (MD) and cognitive neuroscience (MA) at the Hebrew University, and completed his PhD in neuroscience at the Swiss Institute of Technology and the University of Geneva. Specializing in the human cortex, he now works in the clinic of neuropsychiatry and the epilepsy center at the department of neurology at Hadassah Hebrew University Medical Center, and leading the Neuropsychiatry Lab. His main interest is the human self and its subjective experience in physiological and pathological states. He is involved in developing new tools for evaluation and management of neuropsychiatric patients, and puts special efforts in translating clinical neuropsychiatric concepts into a neuroscientific model of a “neurology of self”.
