Main fields of interest are retinal diseases. Her famous unique clinical pioneering research relates to the course of maculopathy following cataract surgery in particular in the diseases age-related macular degeneration and diabetic retinopathy. She published numerous papers in the most prestigious journals, was invited as guest speaker, gave numerous presentations in meetings all over the world. Her work was rewarded for Excellent Papers presented at conferences and meetings.

Involved in multicenter clinical trials, participated in many of the most important studies related to age-related macular degeneration (AMD), diabetic retinopathy and vein occlusion. As a retinal surgeon, very much interested in research related to retinal detachment.

In the recent years, established basic science research laboratory, with several PhD degree investigators to explore diseases with unmet medical needs leading to blindness focusing on dry AMD and PVR (Proliferative Vitreo-Retinopathy).
