

Avner Halperin is the CEO of Sheba Impact – the commercialization and entrepreneurship arm of Sheba Medical Center. He leads the creation of dozens of breakthrough medical technology startups and the creation of a vibrant healthtech ecosystem around Sheba. In addition, he is a Research Fellow at the Middle East Initiative of Harvard Kennedy School, a lecturer at Tel-Aviv University on Big Data Economics, and the Chairman of the Board at EyeControl. Previously, he was the founding CEO of EarlySense – leading the company from an idea to becoming a standard of care in US hospitals – helping save tens of thousands of lives. Earlier he was VP Marketing at Radcom (NASDAQ: RDCM), R&D leader at Eldat (acquired by Pricer (PRIC.ST)), and head of an R&D department in the Intelligence Corps of the IDF.

Avner earned an MSc in Applied Physics from Tel Aviv University and an MBA from MIT where he published research on globally dispersed teams. He is the inventor of 34 US Patents.
