

Adam L. Wollowick, MD/MBA is Sr. Director of Business Development, Stryker Trauma & Extremities. During his tenure at Stryker, he has focused on mergers and acquisitions and led the acquisitions of K2M (\$1.4B), Mobius (\$500M), Artelon, as well as many other transactions. He first joined Stryker in 2014 and led the business development team for Stryker's Spine Division until 2023. During that time, he also had responsibility for the Spine Division's Strategy and Market Intelligence functions.

He held the title of Assistant Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Bronx, NY. Dr. Wollowick is board-certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery. His award-winning research has been presented nationally and internationally at major orthopaedic and spine society meetings and has been published in peer-reviewed journals.
