

Dr. Sarit Batsir is a biotech entrepreneur and oncology expert with extensive experience spanning precision medicine, drug development, molecular diagnostics, and business development. She is the CEO and co-founder of Dio-Tree, a pharmaceutical startup developing a first-in-class therapeutic approach for ovarian cancer by targeting the enzyme DIO3.
