Itzhak (Itzik) Mallayev is a MedTech entrepreneur and biomedical engineer, currently serving as Co-Founder and CEO of STFix Medical, an orthopedic device company developing a novel sutureless fixation platform for rotator cuff repair. The company's technology focuses on improving biomechanical performance, simplifying surgical procedures, and enabling future integration of biological augmentation approaches.

Itzik brings over a decade of experience spanning medical innovation, venture investing, and company building. Prior to founding STFix, he was part of the venture investment team at Johnson & Johnson Innovation (JJDC), where he evaluated and supported investments across MedTech, pharmaceuticals, and digital health in Israel and Europe. His work included technology scouting, cross-functional due diligence, and engagement with early- and growth-stage companies.

His work in orthopedic innovation began at Tel Aviv University, where he led R&D efforts that resulted in the foundational technology behind STFix. This included securing competitive funding and advancing the platform through preclinical validation and a defined FDA 510(k) regulatory strategy.

Itzik holds an MBA in Innovation and Entrepreneurship and a B.Sc. in Biomedical Engineering from Tel Aviv University. In addition to his entrepreneurial activities, he serves as a guest lecturer in the MBA program at the Coller School of Management, teaching topics related to venture creation, market analysis, and early-stage company strategy.
