Anat is the co-founder and CEO of Ukko Inc., a biotech startup backed by top-tier Silicon Valley VCs which is solving food allergies and sensitivities. Ukko uses patient data and machine learning to guide the engineering of food proteins that can be incorporated into food products, plants and therapeutics.

Previously, Anat was an Investment Partner at Innovation Endeavors, a venture firm backed by Alphabet's Eric Schmidt. Anat is also the co-founder of MEET, an education nonprofit that since 2004 has partnered with MIT, Google, Facebook and others to develop a tech and entrepreneurship program empowering a network of Palestinian and Israeli leaders to create positive change in their communities. Anat also worked for Israel's State Attorney, on Capitol Hill and with the World Bank.

She received her PhD from MIT, an MBA from Columbia University and a law degree from Hebrew University.
