Dr. Klickstein is Head of Translational Medicine for the New Indication Discovery Unit (NIDU) at Novartis. NIDU is responsible for the discovery and early clinical development of drugs for new clinical indications that are high growth opportunities with true medical need.

Prior to his current position, Dr. Klickstein was Head of Translational Medicine for Musculoskeletal Diseases at Novartis, where he built an early clinical development group that designed and executed multiple successful Proof-of-Concept studies.

Before joining Novartis over 10 years ago, Dr. Klickstein was a faculty member at Brigham & Women's Hospital in Boston, where he directed a basic research laboratory, had an active clinical practice, and directed the Rheumatology fellowship training program. Dr. Klickstein graduated from the Medical Scientist Training Program at Harvard and is board-certified in Internal Medicine and Rheumatology.
